Differentiating Polynomials

Abstract: Differentiating polynomials is easy when viewed in terms of the coefficients. But when viewed in terms of the zeros of the polynomial, differentiation is actually a subtle and poorly understood operation. The talk will describe some surprising facts and some unsolved problems.
